The state of Illinois is now accepting applications for the first round of its Business Interruption Grant (BIG) program. The program will allocate \$60 million in grants in this first round to bars and restaurants; barbershops, salons and other licensed personal service businesses; gyms and fitness centers; and other businesses types located in the "disproportionately impacted area" zip codes of 61603, 61604, 61605, 61606 and 61610.
